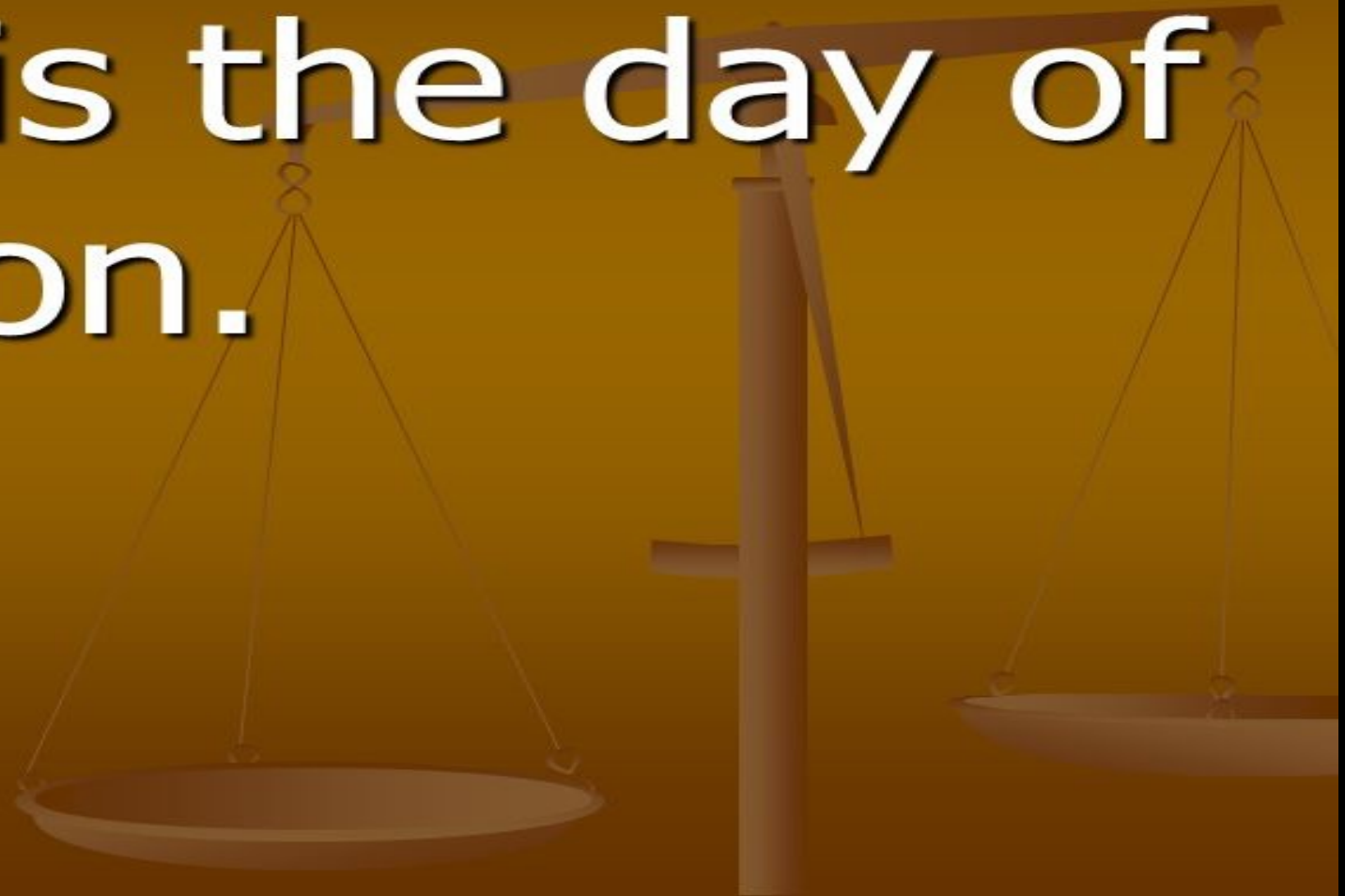

Acts 3:19-19 Now repent of your sins and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped away.

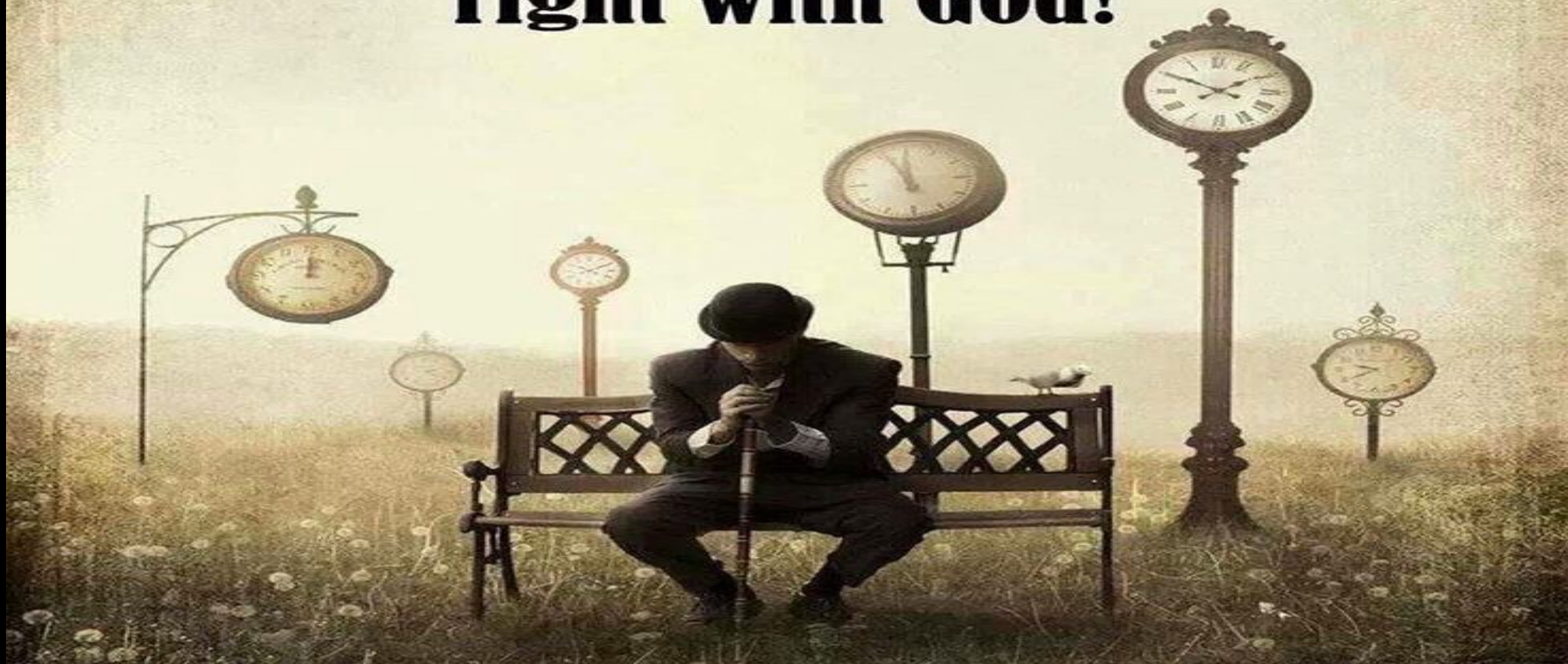
Acts 17:30-30 “God overlooked people’s ignorance about these things in earlier times, but now he commands everyone everywhere to repent of their sins and turn to him.

9 If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

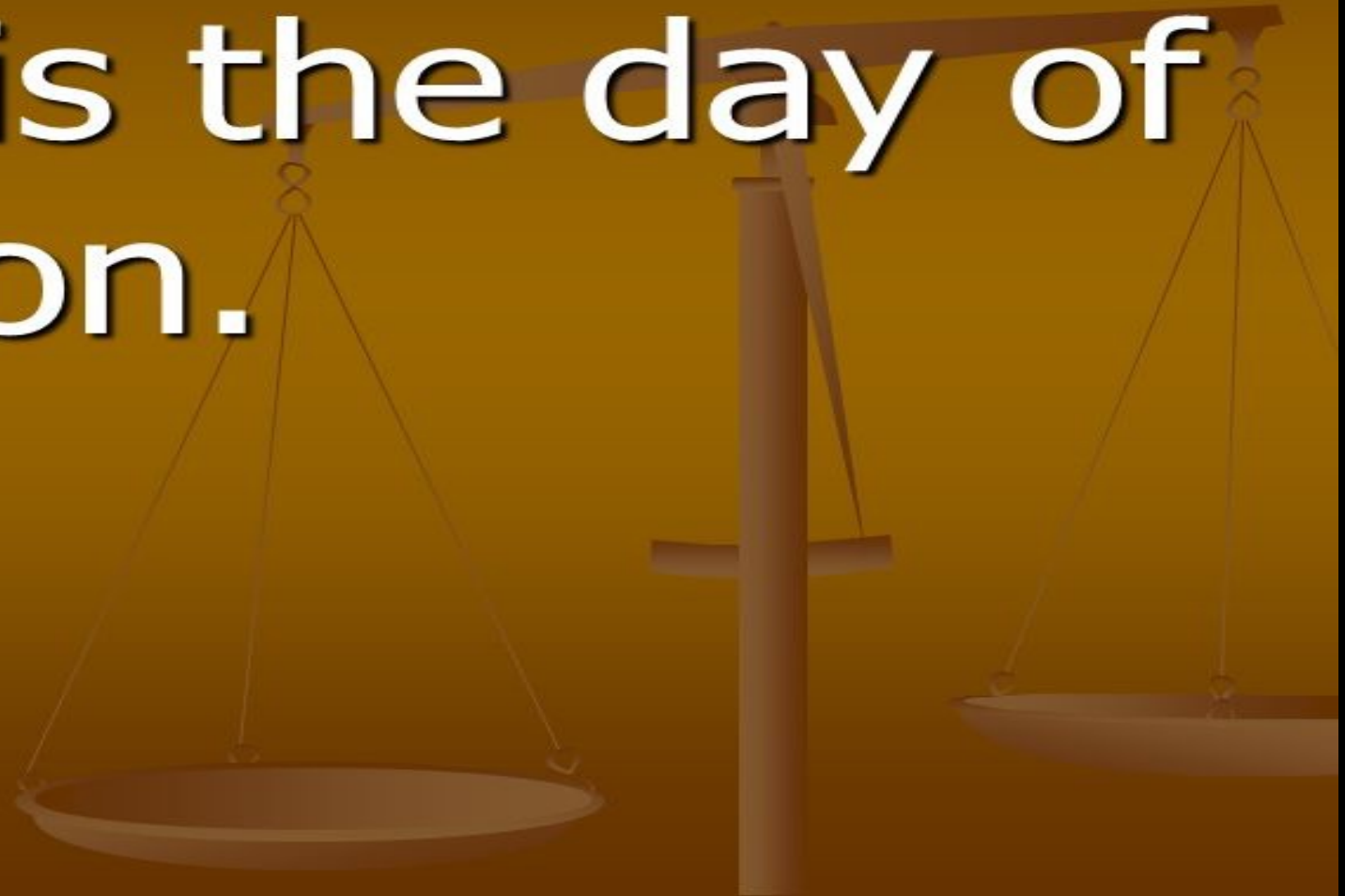

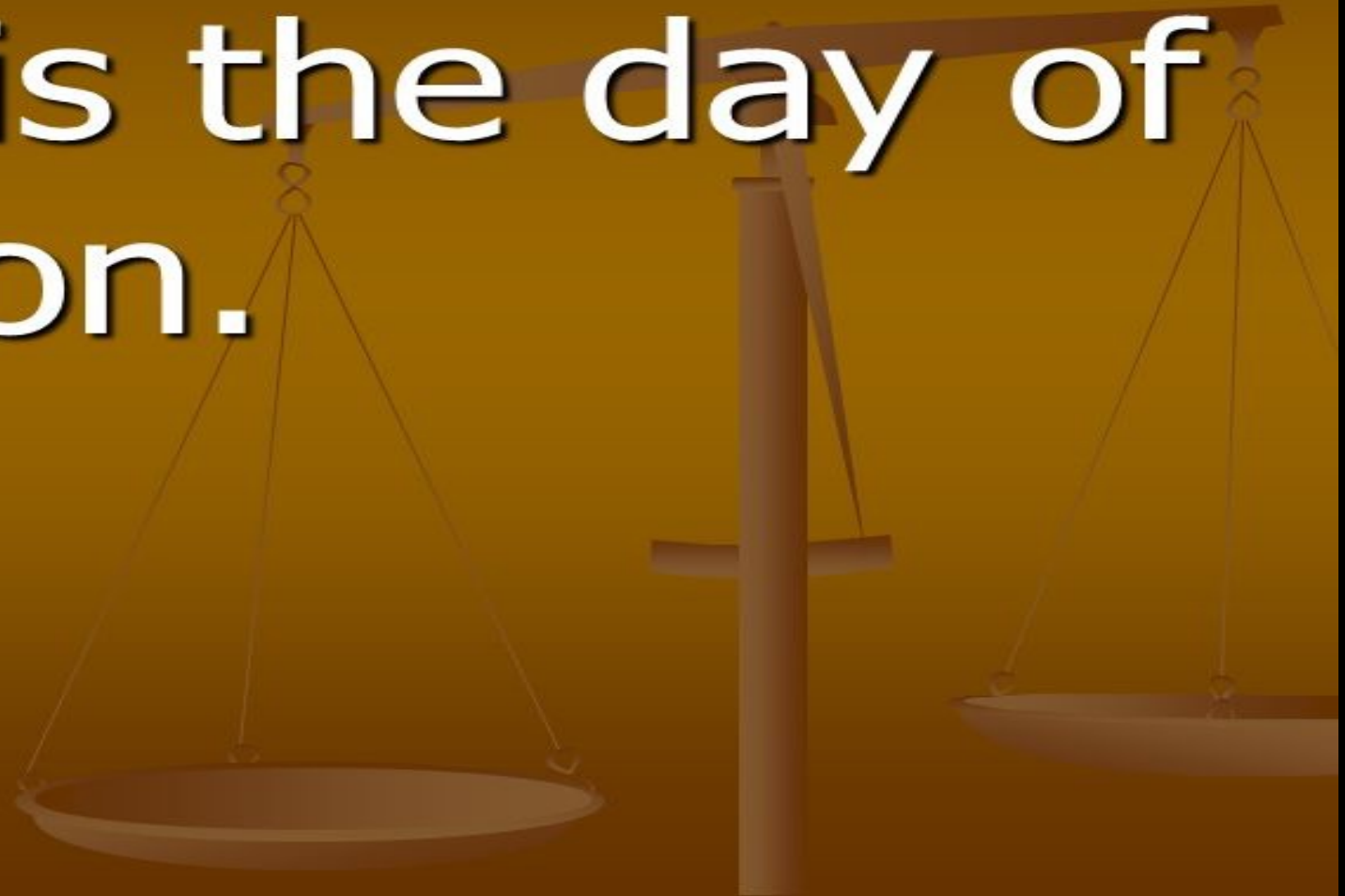
# WHAT'S THE RUSH?
